Shooting Facility Rules

Authority: The Board of Directors has established the following range rules to govern the shooting activities at the **Quinton Sportsmen's Club Inc.**

Purpose: The following Range Rules and regulations are established to ensure safety and discipline for members and guests on the ranges and property as well as safety for our neighbors and surrounding community.

Enforcement: All members are expected to politely point out to the shooter in violation of these rules, the nature of the violation, request that they stop and report the incident along with the violator's name to:

Penalties: The **board of directors** will review all reports of range violations and after meeting with the member in question, will take one of the following actions:

1. No Action;
2. Verbal Warning;
3. Written Reprimand;
4. Temporary Suspension of membership
5. Revocation of membership

Range Rules:

Range Hours:

Sunday - Saturday: 8:30 a.m. to sunset

1. Do not bring any illegal substance(s) onto the property.
2. No alcohol or persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol allowed.
3. Do not shoot over the berms [Dirt embankments]. All rounds fired must fall within the confines of the berms.
4. Only shoot down range.
5. Paper targets are the preferred kind. If any other targets are brought in the range it is your responsibility to dispose of them. Glass targets are not permitted on the range at any time.
6. No fully automatic weapons allowed (the only exception would be for a properly licensed dealer). Each shot must result from a separate pull of the trigger.
7. Throw away targets after use, as well as any spent brass, ammunition containers or trash. Please take away what you bring.
8. Do not put live ammo into trashcans.
9. No illegal guns are permitted on the range at any time.
10. The range officer in charge, when present, has total control of all activities on the range and must be obeyed. With unanimous prior consent from the board of directors, the range officer may modify range rules for an event.
11. No firearms on the archery range.
12. Inspect the range for hazards prior to use.

13. Politely and positively respond when corrected concerning a violation of range rules.
14. This range is for members only. Any member may bring his or her spouse or dependent children out to use the facility. Members may bring and supervise guests on an infrequent basis only. All others are welcome to apply for membership. You are responsible for your guests. Any person under 18 yrs. old must be accompanied by an adult while at the range. NO exceptions. Trespassers will be prosecuted.
15. Any member may check to see if someone is a member while they are using the grounds. All members using the grounds other than during sponsored events are required to carry proof of membership and a form of picture ID. All trespassers should be reported to a board member.
16. No unauthorized vehicles allowed on the range.
17. Shooters must shoot from the same firing line. If there is disagreement among the shooters, the firing line shall be a parallel line in front of the shelter.
18. Be courteous to other shooters. They have the same privilege to use the range as you do.
19. This range is maintained by the members, all users are required to assist in its upkeep, whether by individual effort or by attending the various "Workdays". It takes all of us to make this a safe and successful club.
20. Military Armor piercing, tracer, and incendiary ammunition will not be fired at any time.
21. Muzzle loading firearms (rifle, carbine and pistol) that are loaded from bulk powder containers (powder flasks or pellets) will be loaded behind the firing line and remain uncapped or unprimed until it is the shooters turn to shoot and he/she is on the firing line.
22. Metal Silhouette targets are not to be shot with high powered rifles.
23. When entering through the front gate, you must close and relock the gate once you have entered or exited.

Safety Rules:

1. No alcohol or persons under the influence of alcohol in the range area during shooting.
2. Do not handle any firearm while someone is forward of the shooting line.
3. Keep muzzle pointed in a safe direction (down range) at all times.
4. Insure every firearm is unloaded before leaving the firing line.
5. Eye and ear protection are mandatory.
6. Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to fire.
7. Handle every firearm as if it were loaded.
8. Never point a firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy.
9. Keep all guns unloaded except when it is your turn to shoot and you are at the firing line.
Never leave a firearm loaded while not in use.

All firearms should be in one of the following conditions when not in use:

1. Unloaded slide locked back.
2. Unloaded and cylinder open.
3. Unloaded and bolt open.
4. Unloaded in a holster or case.
5. Muzzle loading firearms must remain uncapped.
